ORDINANCE NO. 135

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CUT AND SHOOT, TEXAS, ADOPTING A NEW MUNICIPAL BUILDING PERMIT INSPECTION AND PLAN REVIEW FEE SCHEDULE FOR ALL RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS IN THE CITY; ASSESSING A TEN PERCENT (10%) ADMINISTRATIVE CHARGE TO EACH FEE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A TEXAS OPEN MEETINGS CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AFTER PUBLICATION

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Cut and Shoot, Montgomery County, Texas, has adopted certain codes published by the International Code Council (ICC) and National Fire Protection Association, as may be amended from time to time, relating to all applicable building, mechanical, electrical, and plumbing codes for both commercial and residential structures; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of these International Code Series as published by the International Code Council (ICC) and the National Electrical Code published by the National Fire Protection Association is done to facilitate proper inspection activities by the City of Cut and Shoot, Texas, relating to construction and to maintenance of all buildings and structures within the corporate limits of said City of Cut and Shoot, Texas, and relating to public safety, health, and general welfare; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has engaged the firm of Bureau Veritas to provide commercial and residential building inspections and plan reviews that conform to the building codes adopted by the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to recent Texas legislation, the City Council finds it necessary to approve residential building permit and inspection fee schedules to charge fees for new residential construction, based upon total covered area rather than the value of construction; and therefore a separate schedule is necessary; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it also necessary to approve commercial building permit and inspection fee schedules for existing and commercial construction in the City;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CUT AND SHOOT, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION I.

The Bureau Veritas Fee Schedule for residential and commercial building permit, inspection and plan reviews relating to all residential and commercial construction in the City is hereby adopted, as attached and incorporated in Attachment "A.". The City will charge an additional ten percent (10%) of each fee listed in Attachment A to cover the City's administrative expenses for processing and collecting these fees.

SECTION II.

REPEALING CLAUSE. Any matters in this Ordinance which are contrary to existing Ordinances of the City of Cut and Shoot, Montgomery County, Texas, shall prevail; and all other Ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed to the extent of any conflict.

SECTION III.

SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, provision or part of this Ordinance shall be held invalid for any reason, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby but shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION IV.

TEXAS OPEN MEETINGS ACT. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was considered was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, of the Texas Government Code.

SECTION V.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication as provided by law.
